CONFERENCES

It was great to see so many of you at conferences last week! Did you know we had 24 out of 26 parents attend? That's awesome! Thank you!

In language arts this week we continued our work with expository non-fiction text. The kids spent time generating "I Wonder" statements to help them better understand what was being read to them and also what they were reading. We used a book titled Animal Senses. **Just a reminder that reading calendars are due Tuesday, Nov. 1st.**

We wrapped up our mini-unit on geometry this week. The kids learned about quadrilaterals, lines, rays, and more in this unit. There are quick quiz and unit test results in the Friday folder.

In our writing curriculum, the kids have been practicing writing opinions about various topics they have chosen. Next week the students will have to choose one topic to write a persuasive essay about using the full writing process. Please talk with your student to find a topic that they are passionate about. They also need to be able to research this topic for facts that support their opinion.

In social studies we are nearing completion of chapter 4-the Northeast region. The kids are currently putting together their region map booklet. We will start a unit in Science about Geology next week.
